### Bunning's Barbecues

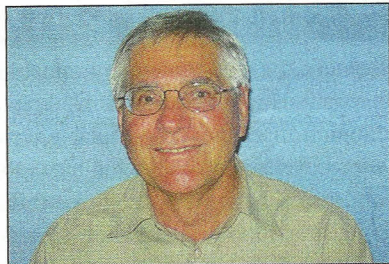
